



**Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students
Under the Coronavirus AID, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act**

The US Department of Education has provided Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students who are in need of financial support for their expenses related to the disruption of our campus operations due to Coronavirus, to including food, housing, course materials, technology, health care and childcare. In determining eligibility for an Emergency Financial Aid Grant, the campus uses the US Department of Education's calculation of Expected Family Contribution (EFC), which takes into account factors such as household income, numbers of dependents with the household, expenses required for program completion, cost of living, and other financial factors. Students who are eligible for U.S. Title IV benefits that are active or on leave of absence with a degree or diploma program as of Friday, March 13, 2020 will be eligible to receive a grant.
